COMMUNICATION NO. 002.

We reject and denounce to the Colombian and international community the racism, misogyny, aporophobia and consequently the political violence systematically exercised by the Colombian magazine REVISTA SEMANA, against the Vice President of Colombia and Minister of Equality Dr. FRANCIA ELENA MARQUEZ MINA, and the Black, Afro-Colombian, Raizal and Palenquero People.

The magazine REVISTA SEMANA, since the election of our Vice President, has repeatedly made biased and insulting publications against the Vice President of Colombia and Minister of Equality Dr. FRANCIA ELENA MARQUEZ MINA, which not only constitute a political attack, but also heighten the risk in which she has been constantly for her struggles in defense of human, ethnic and environmental rights in favor of the entire Colombian population.

The most recent attack occurred in the publication made on March 28, 2024, called "Francia is not a prophet", whereby through lies, misrepresentations, insults and slander, the magazine disqualifies her work as Vice President and Minister of Equality of this government, serving to transform the historical social and economic debt towards, not only communities of Northern Cauca, but also territories and communities across the country, which have been victims for centuries of the inequalities and inequities in previous governments.

Likewise, we denounce that, in such desperate effort to misinform and destabilize the Government of Change, those actions undermine the collective and individual rights of governance of the Black, Afro-Colombian, Raizal and Palenquero People.

For these reasons:

We file a complaint before the Attorney General's Office for possible criminal acts committed by the magazine REVISTA SEMANA and its journalists.

We request the Committee for the Elimination of Discrimination Against Women – CEDAW, of the UNITED NATIONS, to adopt the necessary measures to prevent that the Vice President and

Minister of Equality, Dr. FRANCIA ELENA MÁRQUEZ MINA, continues to be the object of racis, and discrimination on the part of the magazine REVISTA SEMANA and its journalists.

We call on national and international organizations, human rights advocacy groups, popular movements, and citizens in general to speak out against political persecution, misogyny, aporophobia, racism and discrimination against the Colombian Vice President and Minister of Equality – Dr. FRANCIA ELENA MARQUEZ MINA, on the part of the magazine REVISTA SEMANA and its journalists.

We urge the Observatory of Racial Discrimination – ODR, to document the case of political persecution, misogyny, aporophobia and deep-rooted racism towards the Vice President of Colombia and Minister of Equality Dr. FRANCIA ELENA MARQUEZ MINA by the magazine REVISTA SEMANA and its journalists, as well as taking the steps required from that examination.

We request the DEPARTMENT OF NATIONAL PLANNING, in coordination with the MINISTRY OF THE INTERIOR, to issue some information clips, in different media and social networks, about the actions of this government headed by the Vice President and Minister of Equality Dr. FRANCIA ELENA MÁRQUEZ MINA.
